

Jaunt Jottings for March 25th 2023

This month we are heading south to the beautiful semi-rural area of Middle Boambee. Both of our visits are on small acreages (hectarages?) but the terrain is flat and easily managed.

10.00ish Morning tea will be at the Boambee Soccer Field. Take the overpass which directs left to Toormina and right onto Lindsays Road. Drive along Lindsays Road for approximately 2kms and turn right onto Middle Boambee Rd. The field is on the right hand corner of Middle Boambee Road and Ayrshire Park Drive. You will need a chair if you wish to rest the feet.

10.30ish Continue on Ayrshire Park Drive to Amanda Close on the right. We are visiting Coffs member Anne Dew's garden at No 20. There is plenty of parking on the circular driveway.

Anne and husband Tony have maintained a large area but both are keen golfers so there are some big decisions to be made.

11.30ish Retrace your steps back onto Middle Boambee Road and the last driveway on the right before you arrive back at Lindsay's Road is our next garden (No 19) It has a high well manicured hedge in front. Please park on the road unless mobility is an issue when you may park on the driveway inside if necessary
